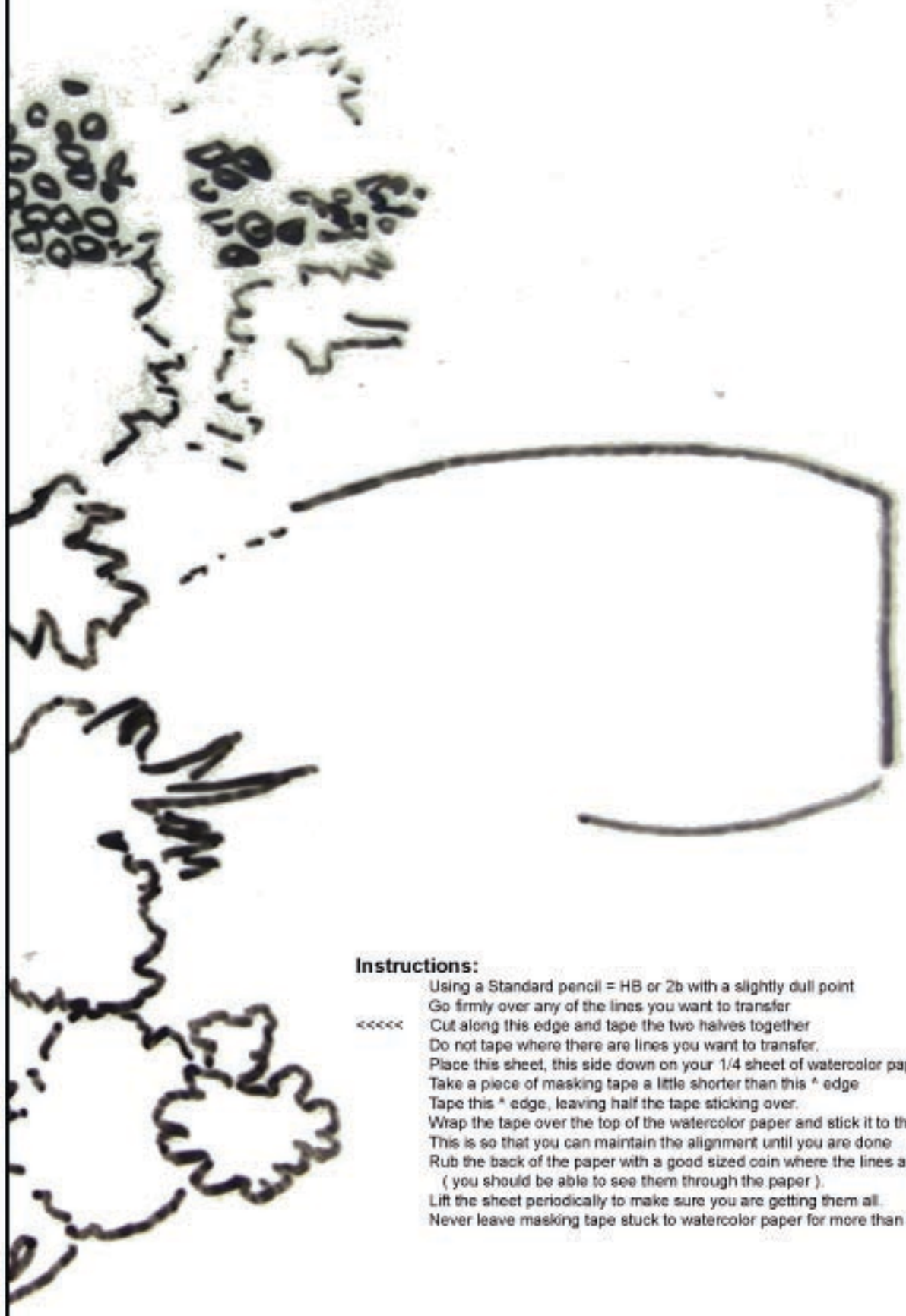




Reference Line



**Instructions:**

- Using a Standard pencil = HB or 2b with a slightly dull point
- Go firmly over any of the lines you want to transfer
- <<<<< Cut along this edge and tape the two halves together
- Do not tape where there are lines you want to transfer.
- Place this sheet, this side down on your 1/4 sheet of watercolor paper
- Take a piece of masking tape a little shorter than this ^ edge
- Tape this ^ edge, leaving half the tape sticking over.
- Wrap the tape over the top of the watercolor paper and stick it to the back
- This is so that you can maintain the alignment until you are done
- Rub the back of the paper with a good sized coin where the lines are
- ( you should be able to see them through the paper ).
- Lift the sheet periodically to make sure you are getting them all.
- Never leave masking tape stuck to watercolor paper for more than a few hours.
